

Participation is only by invitation, based on EOI send outs from Chairperson or nomination by Chairperson.

Development & Infrastructure Committee (D&I Committee) members need to be:

- Representative of or attuned to the needs of significant parts of Fremantle's D&I economy. e.g. leading an industry or community network.
- Operationally involved day-to-day in Fremantle's D&I sector. e.g. have 'skin in the game' e.g.
 CEO's more than Chair.
- · Collaborative as demonstrated by past behaviour e.g. participation in forums, partnerships.
- Adding diversity to the perspectives already represented e.g. geographical, sectoral, gender, demographic, expertise.
- Capable of attending regular bi-monthly meetings, and of turning insights into action e.g. sufficient resources, influence, ability to help achieve the objectives.
- Must make their best available attempts to attend all meetings.
- · Able to attend in person (not via Zoom).
- Ready to provide opportunities and feedback to the FCC CEO on major projects/decisions which will impact on member businesses/sectors.
- · Agreeing to abide by the FCC member code of conduct.

Purpose

Facilitate effective collaboration amongst key industry and community organisations.

Objectives

- Facilitates open communication for mutual and systemic benefit.
- · Addresses the gap in strategy for Fremantle D&I.
- Key leaders an opportunity to discuss key initiatives, developments and trends.
- · Feeds into agenda and follows on from recommendations of major public forums.



Objectives (Continued)

- Enable diverse stakeholders to develop a shared understanding of the status, trends and economic climate.
- Facilitate alignment and collaboration on priority actions towards a shared vision.
- Provide opportunity for members to connect and share information about upcoming projects, business developments/opportunities.

Ethos.

- Non-binding, confidential (Chatham House Rule) conversations
- Agenda driven by Chairperson (FCC CEO) and participants some predetermined, some emergent
- · Create space for creativity and connection, being casual and authentic.
